I was asked by Brendan Cooney, State AOH Veteran Affairs representative and Alexandria Division member to support this funeral procession as there was minimal representation that could attend from NY. We had Jay Mc Carthey and others from the State come to this event. The Devine family really appreciated our support and honor of Father Devine. I personally wanted to honor him as my uncle died in Vietnam and Fr. Devine

served with distinction as a Catholic chaplain in Vietnam. Fr. Devine was also at 9/11 serving in the morgue during the sad days following the attack on the World Trade Center. I was in NYC for the rescue and wanted to honor and thank Fr. Devine for his service to our first responders and countrymen who did not survive that day. It was a sad but proud military ceremony, with a horse drawn caisson, Army band, taps, riderless horse, 21- gun salute and other military traditions bestowed upon our heroes. Thank our Country for honoring Brother AOH member Fr. Kevin Devine from NY.
